#### Introduction

#### Introduction

By law, councils have to publish a monthly Forward Plan containing available details of all "Key Decisions" that they are aware of which will be taken by councillors or officers during the forthcoming four-month period.

As part of Barking and Dagenham Council's commitment to open government it has extended the scope of its Forward Plan so that it includes all known issues, not just "Key Decisions", that are due to be considered by its main decision-making bodies, as well as looking as far ahead as possible and not just at the next few months. Barking and Dagenham Council also recognises the importance of encouraging local people to have their say on the decisions that affect them, their families and the community as a whole.

Key decisions are defined as:

- (i) Those that form the Council's budget and policy framework (this is explained in more detail in the Council's Constitution)
- (ii) Those that involve 'significant' spending or savings
- (iii) Those that have a significant effect on the community

In relation to (ii) above, Barking and Dagenham's definition of 'significant' is spending or savings of £200,000 or more that is not already provided for in the Council's Budget (the setting of the Budget is itself a Key Decision).

In relation to (iii) above, Barking and Dagenham has also extended this definition so that it relates to any decision that is likely to have a significant impact on one or more ward (the legislation refers to this aspect only being relevant where the impact is likely to be on two or more wards).

#### Information included in the Plan

In relation to each decision, the Plan includes as much of the following information as is available when it is published:

- the subject matter
- the Member-level meeting taking the decision (Barking and Dagenham does not delegate the taking of key decisions to officers)
- the projected date when the matter will be considered
- any groups/persons to be consulted before the matter is considered
- how any such consultation will be carried out
- a list of relevant documents to be submitted to the decision-taker in connection with the matter under consideration

#### How you can have your say

Each entry in the Plan gives details of the main contact officer if you wish to make representations about the item or would just like some further information. Alternatively you can telephone Barking & Dagenham Direct on 020 8215 3000 (Monday to Friday, 8am - 6pm).

Columns 3 and 4 provide information on the individuals and groups, both internal and external, that are to be consulted on any proposals as well as how any such consultation will be carried out.

Column 5 gives the details of the main contact officer for the item.
