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Summary NHS partners across north east London (NEL) are consulting on proposals to increase the number of checks, scans and tests across our boroughs. One of the proposals is to build a dedicated Community Diagnostic Centre at Barking Community Hospital, for a range of diagnostics such as CT and MRI scans, ultrasounds and blood tests.
