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Summary Nationally, mental health has been a focus over previous years. During the Covid-19 period, there was a significant increase in mental health focus and in particular, the relationship between lockdown, social stressors, the cost-of-living crisis, isolation and increasing trends around domestic violence and safeguarding concerns. Previously, NELFT has presented on the matter of what the Trust is doing in relation to transforming community mental health services (minute 3, 30 June 2021 refers). This item provides an update to the Health Scrutiny Committee on the progress of the Barking and Dagenham Community Mental Health Transformation Programme.
