Summary

At its meeting on 10 May 2011, the Cabinet is to consider the attached report (Appendix A) on proposals for the disposal of, and delivery of residential accommodation on the remainder of the King William Street Quarter (former Lintons site) and the Eastern End of Thames View.

The Council's new Financial Rules, adopted on 23 February 2011 (Minute 29 refers), require that all land disposals must now be approved by the Assembly. As Recommendation 3 within the attached report relates to the disposal of the land the matter is referred for the Assembly's consideration.
