<p><i>This regular report on the work of the Development Control Board is submitted under Article 2, Paragraph 9.2 of the Constitution.</i></p> <p>Summary</p> <p>This summarises the business transacted by the Development Control Board since their last report to the Assembly.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The Development Control Board has met two times (21 January and 3 February 2004) since they last reported to the Assembly, a total of 10 planning applications have been presented. From these applications, 6 were decided in accordance with the officers' recommendation. Out of the remaining 4, 3 were refused and 1 was deferred.2. The Board noted that 2 Town Planning Appeals had been lodged and 4 had been determined as 3 accepted and 1 dismissed.3. Details of applications determined by the Director of Leisure and Environmental Services under delegated authority were presented covering the period 12 December 2003 to 21 January 2004.
