- Comprehensive Performance Assessment is the key external measure of the Council's performance, bringing together our corporate ability and the quality of our services
- Barking and Dagenham Council retained its fair rating in December 2003

Key Changes

1. CPA from 2005 is likely to focus strongly on corporate performance on shared priorities between central and local government. These include: -
 - Sustainable communities and transport
 - Safer and stronger communities
 - Healthier communities
 - Children and young people

Key Changes(2)

2. The Council's contribution to the Borough's Community Strategy will take on greater importance
3. Services to children will be assessed through a new single service block for children and young people
4. Greater emphasis will be given to the Council's financial management and use of resources

Key Issues for LBBD Council

1. The Council will receive a full corporate assessment in 2005
2. The Council needs to decide whether it wishes to become a pathfinder for CPA in 2004
