Summary:

The Health and Social Care Act 2012 conferred a range of statutory powers and functions on the Health and Wellbeing Board forming an integral part of the Council's overall political structure. This means that all Board meetings are conducted in accordance with the Council's Constitution and that, by and large, Board Members share a similar status with Councillors and Co-opted Members of the Authority, and are therefore bound by certain codes and protocols.

In order for Members of the Board to understand what that status means in practical terms and learn more about the governance arrangements and meetings procedure, John Dawe (Group Manager, Democratic Services) will give a brief introduction to the Council's political structure, the governance of the Board, and explain the standing orders that underpin the mechanics of Board meetings.
