Action(s) since last report to the Health and Wellbeing Board

- The Sub-Group members discussed Children's Mental Health in particular the requirement for there to be a joint Children and Young People's Mental Health Transformation Plan based on the *Future in Mind* guidance. The Sub-Group considered how the planned Children and Young People's Needs Assessment, Children's IAPT programme can support the development of the plan and how the MH and CMG sub-groups can work effectively together. This will be a particular priority over the coming months.
