Dear Sir/Madam

I wish to object the application from Mr Sahin Tasyurdu for a Premises License for the sale of alcohol at 9-10 The Triangle, Tanner Street, Barking, Essex IG11 8QA.

My objection is based on my concern that this new license may increase the possibility of public nuisance for the Many dwellings nearby, including my own. The location is extremely close to residential houses. This will increase the possibility for inappropriate behaviour.

I am particularly concerned about the noise nuisance as this already happens occasionally and this could increase with people congregating outside and nearby properties. Currently nearby residents have had to put up fencing to stop people leaning against their front walls and drinking. I have attached pictures for your reference.

The selling of alcohol would also encourage a drinking culture nearby and invariably make its way into local streets and into the local park. We have recently seen a lot of problems with youngsters and adults drinking in Barking Park and having another off licence would encourage more bad behaviour. Barking Park sits predominately in a residential area.

As there are residential properties and gardens in the immediate vicinity, this could increase to more litter been thrown on the street outside or left on the walls of residents houses.

Activity involving increased numbers of people, vehicles and alcohol after 11.30 is not appropriate for a residential area and increases the possibility of becoming a public nuisance and significantly raises the risk of criminal disorderly behaviour, prostitution and drugs.

Parking in the area would be a problem and the residents are currently facing big problems with parking at present.
