### Summary

North East London CCG is working with NHS and social care partners on proposals for the development of a Health and Wellbeing Hub on the former St George's Hospital site in Hornchurch, Havering.

In 2019, the Prime Minister announced that the NHS was to receive £17 million to take forward plans for the new health and wellbeing centre at the former St George's Hospital site in Suttons Lane and health and care partners are working together to plan much needed integrated community-based health services in Havering. Health and care partners have since been working in collaboration on the Outline Business Case for the development.

Members are asked to note the plan for a 12-week period of public engagement, starting in November 2021, to allow people across Barking and Dagenham, Havering and Redbridge to share their views on the proposals.

The Health Scrutiny Committee (HSC) is recommended to note the report provided by the CCG, and the engagement approach proposed. Following the information provided, the HSC should discuss any issues that need further exploration with NHS representatives.
