# Increasing Community Engagement

- Role of Police Service misunderstood
- Intention to communicate this better through the internet, libraries, supermarkets and community centres
- Ideas are requested on how to expand and make neighbourhood watch more widespread

# **Accountability of Policing (1)**

- Intention to delegate responsibilities and resources to local police leaders – a more localised policing service
- Home Office considering making community consultation a statutory requirement of police service
- Considering introducing community advocates and Neighbourhood Panels on policing

# Accountability of Policing (2)

- Intention to increase the involvement of local people in the governing arrangements for police through establishing a local Police Board.
- Intention to review the constitutional arrangements and partnership arrangements between the Local Authority and the Police
- Introducing a second non-emergency other number – keeping 999 for emergencies only.

#### **Police Modernisation**

- Home Office intend to reward success with greater freedom of flexibility and take greater policing decisions at local level
- Home Office are considering involving local people in police recruitment, particularly to enhance equalities and diversity
- Police structure is likely to change, moving away from command and control methods

- 5. Is there any need to strengthen the partnership role of the police and if so, how?
- 6. Is there support for a non-emergency phone number in addition to 999?
