REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE STRATEGY

CODE OF CORPORATE GOVERNANCE FOR DECISION

This report is submitted to the Executive as it deals with an important issue concerning the corporate management of the Council.

Summary

In line with a framework produced by CIPFA (the Chartered Institute of Public Finance & Accountancy) and SOLACE (the Society of Local Authority Chief Executives and Senior Managers), the Council agreed a Code of Corporate Governance towards the end of 2003. It is included in the Council Constitution.

The Code is an expression of the Council's commitment to good corporate governance and it provides an explanation of what the Council does to achieve this.

The Council put in place an annual review process to make sure that the Code is kept up to date. Accordingly, just over one year on, this report suggests a few changes to achieve this. The changes are shown in bold type on the appended Code (Appendix A).

Recommendation

The Executive is asked to:

- 1. Consider the suggested revisions on the appended code; and
- 2. Recommend the Assembly to agree the suggested revisions and the associated changes necessary to the Council Constitution.

Reasons

To comply with the Corporate Governance Framework set by CIPFA and SOLACE and meet the expectations of the Council's external auditors.
