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Summary: The Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection of Barking Havering and Redbridge University Hospitals NHS Trust took place from the 14 – 17 October 2013 and the Trust was the second in London to be scrutinised under the new inspection model. The final CQC report was published in December 2013. Following their inspection, the CQC recommended that the Trust be placed into special measures, publicly recognising and reinforcing that the Trust must make significant improvements. Particular areas of focus centred on the emergency pathway and overall organisational structures and processes to oversee and drive improvement in the quality of services. The attached Improvement Plan sets out what the Trust will do to meet these challenges.
